Please indicate your preference for oral or poster presentation format. For electronic submissions the preferred file format is pdf, although MS Word and postscript files are also acceptable.

Submissions will be evaluated for originality, significance of the work, technical soundness, and interest to a wide audience. Authors will be notified of acceptance by April 26, 2002. Final accepted papers (4 pages in length) must be received by **June 14, 2002** to be included in the published Proceedings.
